



# <u>Year 5 Homework Letter - Friday 15th March 2024</u>

This week has been assessment week. The children have taken part in 'special challenges' in Reading, Writing and Maths. They have worked extremely hard and should be very proud of themselves!

### <u>English</u>

We are continuing to read our class text: Hidden Figures. This week we have written a diary entry in role and considered the use of superlatives such as smartest, bravest, most resilient, to describe how the women will need to behave in order to succeed at NASA.

#### Maths

This week we finished our work learning about fractions, decimals and percentages. We have started a new unit, learning to find the perimeter of shapes. We have started by recapping our knowledge of measure: 1 cm = 10 mm 1 m = 100 cm

We have also considered different ways to find the perimeter of a rectangle and a square using what we know about the length of the sides.

#### Homework

**Spelling:** The children should complete the 10 spellings for Spring 2 Week 4 set on Purple Mash.

**Maths:** Please practise all times tables on Times Tables Rock Stars.

**Reading:** The children must also read for at least 15 minutes per day and comment in their reading log. We expect these to be in school with the children every day.
