



# <u>English</u>

This week, we have begun reading 'Flotsam'. This is another wordless picture book about a young boy's journey to the beach which leads him to discover (so far) a fantastic underwater world. This week we have talked about fantasy and reality genres. We went to the library to see what books of that genre we could find, using the blurb to help us. Then we investigated images from the text thinking about what 'I know, I think I know and I want to know. Finally we wrote paragraphs about the beginning using fronted adverbials—remembering the comma!
