<u>English</u>

This week we have continued to read 'The Tin Forest'. In our lessons we have predominantly looked at verbs and adjectives. We used a variety of verbs to describe what the old man does to clear the rubbish around him. Using a thesaurus, we found synonyms for 'sad' and ranked them accordingly to impact and wrote a letter of advice to the main character. Finally we wrote noun phrases to describe the dream forest that he dreamt about every night.

<u> Maths</u>

In Maths we have now completed our unit of shape. The children should now understand:

- what an angle is
- what a right angle is
- different lines horizontal, vertical, parallel and perpendicular
- properties of shapes relating to these mathematical concepts - for example a rectangle has all four lines and 4 right angles

Shapes and angles are all around us! Ask your child to find these things around them.

Expressive Arts

This term, in Music, we have enjoyed learning a disco themed song called 'Bringing Us Together'. The children are enjoying using glockenspiels and recorders to accompany the singing. In Art, with 'The Tin Forest' as our inspiration, we looked at Henri Rousseau's 'Surprised' and enjoyed sketching, and now painting, our own tigers. The children are looking forward to show casing their art at the Art Exhibition in July.
