Reading Comprehension:

The children have looked at many different extracts in their learning this week. Their learning this week has again focus ed on their Reading and Comprehension skills in preparation for SA Ts. We have looked at four different question types:

- Distinguishing between fact and opinion
- A statement with supportive evidence
- According to the text ... who, what where why...
- What does this mean?

The children have been working as pairs and teams to find the relevant information to support their answers. They have been looking at extracts from: Charles Dickens, Harry Potter, A lice in wonderland, Skellig, Children of WW2 and Charlie and the Chocolate Factory.

Maths:

Our daily Maths lessons this week we have been recapping elements from the Spring and Autumn terms. The children have focused on: solving mixed operation word problems, questions involving prime numbers, multiples of numbers and factors of numbers before recapping converting units of measurement.

In the afternoons our focus has moved toward arithmetic practise. This week we have worked on:

- Multiplying fractions by a whole number
- Multiplying fractions by a fraction
- Dividing fractions by a fraction or a whole number
- Mixed fractions questions.
