Across the school children have been busy learning about how to keep themselves safe online; being careful not to give out personal information when they are chatting or posting online. Children in Key Stage 1 have learnt that personal information can be anything from your email address or phone number to the name of your pets (commonly used passwords). The children in Key Stage 2 have learnt that accepting emails, messages, texts, images or opening files from people you don't know can lead to problems as they may contain viruses or be nasty messages.
