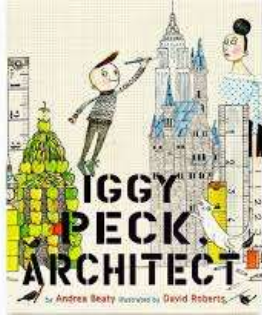




Year 1 Homework Letter - Friday 7th June 2024
