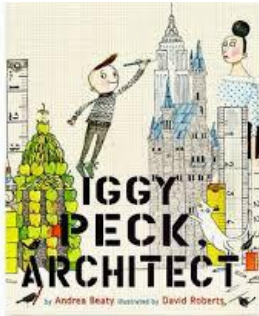




## Year 1 Homework Letter - Friday 21<sup>st</sup> June 2024
