<u>Online Safety</u>

I have overheard a few conversations this week about some apps and games the children are playing on. TikTok has been mentioned by a few children as they were describing videos they have seen to other children. TikTok is an app designed for children aged 13+ because it can be easy for users to encounter inappropriate content on the app through the algorithms. It is not suitable for children in Year 2.

In addition to this, some children have mentioned playing the game Fortnite. This game is rated for ages 13+ due to the online nature, risk of inappropriate language, violence and ability to talk to strangers online. This is not a suitable game for children in Year 2. We are beginning to see and hear some of the children refer to this content and this not appropriate for school or their age.
