Year 3 Homework Letter - Friday 14th June 2024



Next week is assessment week. The children will be taking part in a reading assessment and a White Rose maths assessment.

English

We have continued to read How to Live Forever by Colin Thompson. This week we have thought a lot about the characters and using pictures to infer how a character is feeling. We wrote a short setting description of the land where the 'Ancient Child' lives using noun phrases and prepositions such as behind, over, under and below. Finally, we wrote a diary entry from the 'Ancient Child' concentrating on the use of suffixed words using 'less' and 'ful'.

<u>Maths</u>

In Maths this week we are learning about Money. This is a short unit where the children are learning about:

- Recognising coins
- Convert pounds to pence and vice versa
- Adding pounds and pence
- Subtracting pounds and pence
- Finding change

As with Time, this is a tricky concept for children, especially in a world of contactless! So please practise, if you can, children paying for something in a shop and for them to think about the coins needed and how much change they will receive. The last two units of the year will be fractions and finally statistics.

<u>Science</u>

Our topic this half term is 'Animals including Humans'. First we talk about the difference between plants and animals and that the former make their own food, so the children's task was to create a person who could make their own food! Also, we are learning about the skeleton and how many bones a child and an adult have and why this is? We will be learning about vertebrates and invertebrates.
