Our Learning This Week English

In English, the children have started our new text for this half term, 'Weslandia' by Paul Fleischman. It begins with children creating a shelter for their own civilisation, as a hook to create engagement with the text. The first part then continues with children making predictions, describing Wesley's character and eventually retelling the story in their own words. In the second part, the children begin by creating a non-chronological report, published as a brochure for Weslandia itself, using planning models and information from and inferred from the text.

Maths - Multiplication Tables Check

This week the children have all completed their Multiplication Tables Check. Miss Oastler and I are very proud of them for all of their hard work in preparation for this check and for the mature way in which they conducted themselves whilst doing the check using the i-Pads in the Southwark Room in groups of three. The results of the MTC will be attached on your child's school report which will be sent out later this term.

Our new topic in RE this half term is 'What does it mean to be a Sikh?' During this module the children will be learning about what it means to belong to a community, the key teachings of Sikhism, the Gurdwara and Guru Granth Sahib and the links between Sikhism and Islam. As part of the curriculum the children will be participating in an Indian dance workshop offering a link with the Expressive Arts.

<u>Maypole</u>

The children are learning how to Maypole dance with a performance being given at the Summer Garden Party on the 26th June. We are looking forward to showing you all we have learnt and the performance will no doubt be a special part of our Summer Garden Party. As well as their usual PE lessons, the children will be participating in a number of additional physical activities this half term (listed below).
