Enterprise project.

As we enter the final half term at Nutfield Church, excitement is building within the classroom with the beginning of their Enterprise Project.

The class has been split into five competing groups, with each being given £10 as a budget. After school on Friday 21st June, on the school playground, Year 6 will be selling their created products. This enterprise project is very much child-led, with guidance and direction given when required.

The aim of the project is for the class to research, gather data, design and create a food or drink based product to sell for profit. It's also a great activity to consolidate the maths and writing skills they have worked on this academic year. So far this week the children have gathered data on food and snack preferences from across the school, researched costing of resources and have begun to design their product.

As the deadline for selling gets closer, the children will be requiring the support of their parents to help buy and make their products at home using the budget that I will be giving them next week. Therefore do start to get in contact with parents of other children in their group to best support their business project.

On the morning of the project the children will need to bring in everything that they need into school as prepped and ready as possible. There is limited fridge and freezer space in the school, so please do bare this in mind. Thank you in advance.

Production:

In class we have already started practicing our lines for the Year 6 production of 'Robin Hood and the Nutfield Hoodies'. Over the next term we will continue to work on our lines, stage directions and singing. It's been so pleasing to see the smiles on all their faces as they embrace their roles.

Rehearsals for our production are going well. The children are very enthusiastic. Soon they will be bringing home a list of the costumes required.
