



<u>Year 5 Homework Letter - Thursday 27th June 2024</u>


<u>Englísh</u>

This week we celebrated 'Feeling Good Week'. We created a leaflet about healthy eating, thinking about the different food groups, what they do for the body and how much of each we need to stay well.

We then have also continued to read our story: The Last Bear. The children are enjoying the story and engaging well, not just with the central character, but also with the environmental themes which run through the book.

<u>Maths</u>

This week in Maths we have been learning about negative numbers. The children have been thinking about places where negative numbers may be used, such as a thermometer, measuring depth (at sea) or in a lift. We have been practising sequencing numbers which count through zero and answering some challenge questions, which require an explanation as to why the answer is true or false:



<u>Homework</u>

Spelling: The children should complete the 10 spellings for Summer 2 Week 3 set on Purple Mash. These are the words which will be tested. Again, I am also sending some additional spelling words which feature rules that the children would benefit from revising. There will be no test of these extra words. Maths: Please continue to practise all times tables on Times Tables Rock Stars. Additionally, I am sending multiplication for the children to complete and hand in on Wednesday.

Reading: The children must also read for at least 15 minutes per day and comment in their reading log.
