Spellings

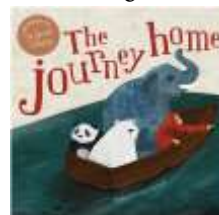
This week's spellings will be set on Purple Mash - I have also photocopied the spelling on the back of this letter as requested by those of you who attended the meet the teacher meeting.
