



Year 3 Homework Letter - 20th September 2024

A busy week for Year 3. The children have been working hard and producing some fantastic work - this week we worked on our Kandinsky's art work which we are looking forward to parents viewing it at our annual Art Expo.

English

This week we have continued to read 'Leon and the Place Between'. We are really enjoying this book about the fun of the circus and a child's imagination. With regards to our writing and grammar, we have been using verbs and fronted adverbials to improve our writing and using drama to embed the story and the character's emotions.

Maths

In Maths our unit is about place value. It is important the children understand that each digit has a different value or worth depending where it is placed. This week we are going big on numbers! We are learning

- Numbers to 1000
- Understanding hundreds, tens and ones
- Partitioning numbers to 1000
- Reading numbers to 1000 on a number line

Homework

Reading: The children engage in silent reading every afternoon for at least 10 minutes and then record this in their reading record. We ask that the children take responsibility for their own reading records and they may record what they have read themselves in pencil or black pen please.

Maths: In Year 3, we need to know the 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables. The children should be using TTRS (Times Tables Rock Stars) to practise these at home, as well as learning them off by heart. Please ask if you would like a poster for home. In class, every day, we practise and this week it is the 2 x table. The aim is to become proficient in each by becoming quicker at working out the answers.

Spellings: Use the online spelling sheet provided to complete this week's spellings which have been set for the children. An optional quiz will also be set on Purple Mash. Please find this week's results in the reading record.
