



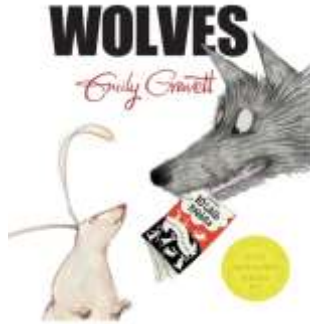
## Year 2 Homework letter - Friday 4th October 2024

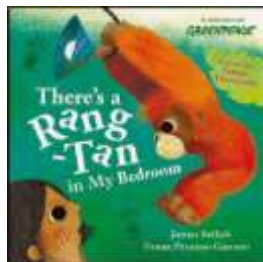
*This week the children have spent time in their maths lesson learning how to log on and navigate both of these exciting programmes on the Ipads.*
