### English

This week we have begun to write our stories based on 'Leon and the Place Between'. We have planned our characters and in our writing we are focusing on:

- Fronted adverbials - showing where, when or how something is happening
- Using adjectives to describe
- Adding speech to show the feelings of the characters

### Maths

In Maths we have moved onto our next unit of White Rose - addition and subtraction. This will lead up to the children learning the column method. This week we have:

- Consolidated our learning on place value
- Practised our number bonds to 10 and related facts for example of  $2 + 3 = 5$  then  $20 + 30 = 50$  and  $200 + 300 = 500$
- Adding and subtracting 1s
- Adding and subtracting 10s

### Homework

**Reading:** Please remember to read every evening with your child. We now ask that the children take responsibility for their own reading records and record what they have done themselves. Do continue to ask them questions about what they have read to test their understanding. The children engage in silent reading every afternoon for at least 10 minutes after lunch.

**Maths:** This week's Maths homework will be practising the 2x, 5x and 10x tables on TTRS (Times Tables Rock Stars). We have been practising using the program in class so the children should now be proficient at logging in and out of TTRS. This week, we have focused on knowing each time table off by heart so this week we have been practising the 10 x table to make sure we are secure in these.

**Spellings:** Use the online spelling sheet provided to complete this week's spellings which have been set for the children. An optional quiz will also be set on Purple Mash to complete.

### Science

In Science we are learning about forces and magnets. So far we have taken part in a number of investigations and this week we worked in small groups to carry out an investigation of our choosing.

In **PE**, we are learning to play tag rugby. This is an opportunity for the children to learn about the rules of this sport - so far we have learnt how to pass the ball and the offside rule. This week we practised working in groups of 5 as attackers and defenders, focusing on how to hold the ball and how to pass, working as a team and to see if the attackers could reach the touchline before losing too many tags.
