English

This week we have continued reading *The First Drawing*. This week we have used a diary entry to describe the day in the life of the stone age boy. Then we used a drama technique called freeze frame when we dive into a scene and think about what is happening and how the characters are feeling. Finally we used emotion words to describe this part of the story.

Homework

Reading: Please remember to read every evening with your child. We now ask that the children take responsibility for their own reading records and record what they have done themselves. The children engage in silent reading every afternoon for at least 10 minutes after lunch. The children are reminded to take their reading records home - please let me know if that is not the case.

Maths: This week's Maths homework will be practising the 2x, 5x and 10x tables on TTRS (Times Tables Rock Stars). We have been practising using the program in class so the children should now be proficient at logging in and out of TTRS. This week, we have focused on knowing each time table off by heart so this week we have been practising the 3 x table to make sure we are secure in these.

Spellings: Use the online spelling sheet provided to complete this week's spellings which have been set for the children. An optional quiz will also be set on Purple Mash to complete.
