

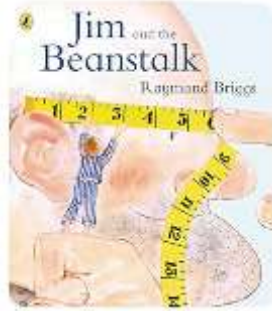


Year 2 Homework letter - Friday 8th November 2024

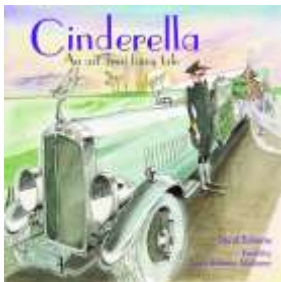


Maths
