### Year 6 Collective Worship – Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> January

In Year 1 this term we have been learning about The Great Fire of London.

On Friday 24<sup>th</sup> January, we had a very exciting visit from the Surrey Fire Brigade. We spent the afternoon outside with 4 firefighters and the fire engine, and they taught us all about old and new ways of putting out fires.

The children had been tasked of making a small replica Stuart house to bring into school; together they made a beautiful Stuart town. During the visit we burnt down our town, under the supervision of the firefighters. We ended our afternoon with all of the children (and teachers) having the opportunity to explore the inside of the fire engine. The children then discovered just how important the fresh ingredients are to the pizza's flavour. Finally, the children added passata (tomato) sauce, mozzarella and basil. The pizzas were then cooked and the children bought them back to school to eat them for lunch. All the children had a fantastic morning and loved learning about the pizza making process. When we got back to school, the children shared their favourite parts of the trip with each other.

Overall, the children were exceptionally well behaved, enjoyed their workshop and would like to thank the restaurant and Manager James for their fantastic experience.
