

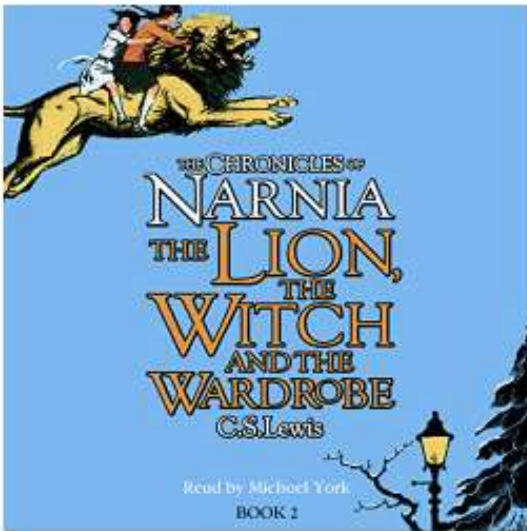


Year 4 Homework Letter - Friday 10th January 2025

Our Learning This Week

English

In English this week, the children have started our new text, 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' by C.S Lewis. We have learnt how to write relative clauses in relation to key aspects of the story so far. The children did so well at this we have written them up to use for our English display board. We also thought about how the author uses the five senses (sight, sound, taste, touch, and smell) to engage the reader. The children were able to find evidence from the text to show how C.S Lewis had achieved this. If you have time over the next week it would be useful for the children to have their own copies - any of the publications will be fine to use.



Homework

The English activities are to learn Spring 1 Week 1 spellings and to read each evening for 15-20 minutes. For Maths, the children must practise all of their times tables on Purple Mash. In preparation for the MTC in May the children are now down to 8 seconds per question.

Maths

This week in Maths, we have continued our topic on 'Multiplication and Division'. The children have progressed from multiplying using informal written methods to the formal written method. The short multiplication method has been introduced for the first time, initially in an expanded form and then in the formal short single-line form.

Love Project

Following the excellent response over the last few years, we have once again decided to support the local charity Love Works as one of our half termly 'love projects.' Love Works is a food bank based in Merstham, but can also offer support with paying utility bills. To support Loveworks, we will be running our 'Tin A Week' project again.
