Our Learning This Week

English

In English this week, we have continued exploring our current text, 'The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe' by C.S Lewis. The children spent time creating a fantasy setting for a story of their own, designing and labelling their set. They then moved on to design alternative characters to the White Witch and Mr Tumnus. The children are using their alternative setting and characters as they start to write their own adaptation of the story. We have continued to read the story together as whole class, chapter by chapter, which the children are thoroughly enjoying.

Maths

This week the children have started their new topic learning about fractions. We began this block by understanding the whole and recapping the part-whole relationship of fractions. The children then built on their knowledge of the whole to explore fractions greater than 1. We then further developed the children's understanding of mixed numbers and explored partitioning mixed numbers in different ways - a skill that will be vital for later steps in this unit of study. We learnt how mixed numbers are represented on a number line and how to convert mixed numbers into improper fractions and improper fractions to mixed numbers.

Homework

The English activities are to learn Spring 1 Week 5 spellings and to read each evening for 15-20 minutes. For Maths, the children must practise all of their times tables on Purple Mash.
