Our Learning This Week

English

In English this week, the children have continued with their exploration of our current text, 'The Lion and the Unicorn' by Shirley Hughes. We have spent time considering what life might have been like for Lenny in his new school as an evacuee. As part of this piece of creative writing the children have learnt how to use apostrophes to show possession.



Maths

In Maths this week, the children have continued studying our current unit on Decimals. One of the areas they have been learning about is how to recognise hundredths as decimals. Representations such as hundred squares, Rekenreks and bead strings were used to help with the children's understanding, along with the introduction of 0.01 decimal place value counters. We explored the idea that ten 0.01s are equivalent to 0.1, meaning that decimal numbers can be partitioned into tenths and hundredths, for example $0.12 = 0.1 + 0.02$.

Homework

The English activities are to learn Spring 2 Week 5 spellings and to read each evening for 15-20 minutes. For Maths, the children must practise all of their times tables on Purple Mash.

Love Project

This year, as part of our Spring term Love Project, we are supporting the Southwark Diocese Lent Appeal. To raise money for we have asked the children to raise money through either giving something up or taking something up for the 40 days of Lent. We are encouraging children to collect sponsorship money for each day they manage this. Lent ends on Thursday 17th April and the children will need to bring in their sponsorship money the first week back of the Summer term.
