English:

This week we have planned, drafted, written and edited our own versions of the story (using the Black Dog as our structure) and added our newly learnt fronted adverbials as well as speech marks and adjectives. There have been some exceptional versions of the story and we are now writing them up in neat for display.

Maths:

This week we have begun our penultimate unit of work on White Rose, angles. We have learnt about:

- what is an angle?
- What is a turn?
- Comparing angles.
- Using a compass and a clock to show the change when completing different turns and angles.

Homework

- sound it out
- Read around the word to see if you can work out the meaning
- Discuss the meaning or look it up in a dictionary if you have one

Multiplication: Please use Times Tables Rock Stars to help improve your child's understanding and knowledge of these. We recommend a few 10 minute sessions a week to practise. It is a fun and interactive way to improve number fluency. Sadly many children are not using it at all. Please can you encourage your child to practise on the weekend.

Spellings: Please practise this week's spellings which are the high frequency words learnt so far since Year 1. Please learn the words over the next few weeks. We will be having a big practise at the end of the term on these words, so we are ready for Year 4!
