### Our Learning This Week

#### English

In English this week we focussed on developing our reading and comprehension skills. Each lesson we read through a text and then explored the questions together finding evidence to support our ideas. The children are doing well at this aspect of the Year 4 curriculum and are making good progress as we head towards the end of the academic year. Next week, we will start to explore our new text for this half term, 'Weslandia' by Paul Fleischman.



#### Maths - Multiplication Tables Check

The children have all completed their Multiplication Tables Check. Miss Oastler and I are very proud of them for all their hard work and preparation and for the mature way in which they conducted themselves whilst doing the check.

#### RE

Our new topic in RE this half term is 'What does it mean to be a Sikh?' During this module the children will be learning about what it means to belong to a community, the key teachings of Sikhism, the Gurdwara and Guru Granth Sahib and the links between Sikhism and Islam. As part of the curriculum the children will be participating in an Indian dance workshop offering a link with the Expressive Arts.

### Maypole

The children are learning how to Maypole dance with a performance being given at the Summer Garden Party on the Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> July. We are looking forward to showing you all we have learnt and the performance will no doubt be a special part of our Summer Garden Party. We are usually scheduled to perform in the first part of the afternoon; as soon as I have had this confirmed by the PTFA I will be sure to let you know.
