Homework

- Read around the word to see if you can work out the meaning
- Discuss the meaning or look it up in a dictionary if you have one

Multiplication: Please use Times Tables Rock Stars to help improve your child's understanding and knowledge of these. We recommend a few 10 minute sessions a week to practise. It is a fun and interactive way to improve number fluency. Sadly many children are not using it at all. Please can you encourage your child to practise on the weekend.

Spellings: Please practise this week's spellings which are the high frequency words learnt so far since Year 1. Please learn the words over the next few weeks. This week we did a big 40 word check.
