Our Learning This Week

English

In English, the children have continued to explore our current text, 'Weslandia'. We have spent time researching and writing paragraphs to describe the different elements of Wesley's civilisation and how each his creations have been made. The children then used this information along with engaging language to create a travel brochure persuading the reader to book a trip to 'Weslandia' as a holiday destination. Next week, as Year 4 draws to a close we are going to focus on the teaching of grammar ensuring that all of the children are secure in the end of year expectations prior to our move up to Year 5.

Maths

This week in Maths we have focussed on the teaching of column addition and subtraction including the use of exchanging and carrying. The children have really grown in their ability in both of these methods during the past year and I am confident that they will be able to successfully apply them to the Year 5 Maths curriculum. Next week we shall be revising multiplication and division as well as continuing to look at multi-step word problems using each of the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).

Homework

The children must practise all of their times tables on Purple Mash and read for at least 15 minutes each day.
