Thank you for all attending the 'Meet the teacher' evening, it was lovely to meet you all.

## **English**

This week we have continued reading 'Cave Baby'. This is the story of a naughty boy who lives in a cave, but focusses on dreams and imagination. The children have enjoyed acting the various characters from cave baby and thinking of an adjective that matches well with the animal. We have also looked at putting sentences in the correct order and understanding the importance of a full stop and capital letter. Next week we will begin to understand how to write a story as a class and then individually.

A reminder that reading books will be changed 3 times a week on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Please read with your child every evening for 10-15 minutes. This is invaluable with regards to how quickly they progress with their reading. Please could you ensure to write in your childs communication book when you have finished a book so we can change it for you. Please also practice the set spellings for this week on Purple Mash.

## This week

The children have continued to grow in understanding their routines. In Science we have started to look at different animal groups and how to sort them. In Religious Education we looked at The Good Samaritan and talked about the importance of kindness. We have also started painting our self-portraits.

#### $\mathcal{PE}$

Thank you for ensuring the children came into school PE ready on their PE day. This made such a difference to the amount of time we had during our lesson. Please do look out for the weather, we will be doing PE outside as much as we can, so do ensure your child has a coat, jumper and jogging bottoms.

#### Maths
