- ➤ We will have lots of creativity and active learning stations


  Most afternoons this half term they will have the opportunity to complete an arts and craft activity




### Curriculum - Maths

- Introducing multiplication and division by exploring groups and sharing (Summer)
























- We look at 12 Books across the year

- In November, we also introduce comprehension activities




## Curriculum – Phonics





### Curriculum – Creative Arts


- Art: Piet Mondrian, LS Lowry, Clarice Cliff

The majority of the tasks will be set on Purple Mash and will support their learning.


Purple Mash logins will be sent home today and stuck inside the children's reading records.

We would like all children to read at home daily.


This only has to be for around 10 minutes and is a great addition to the bedtime routine. Please remember to log it in their reading record.
