Spellings: Twenty Spellings will be set on Purple Mash. Ten spellings from the Year 3/4 curriculum and ten from the Year 2 curriculum. This is set as a 'to do' on 'Purple Mash'.

Passwords: Passwords for Purple Mash, My Maths and Times Tables Rockstars will be sent home with your children. These can be found in the back of the children's reading logs.

P.E and Wellbeing Wednesday.

This academic Year we continue with our Wellbeing Wednesday P.E sessions. This term Year 4 will be having their first session on Wednesday 1st October. On this day the children can come to school in their P.E kit.
